Protect Student Privacy

- Tools should be FERPA and COPPA compliant
- Never enter PII into a chatbot
- Teach students to protect their PII

Communication is Key

Regularly check in with students and caregivers to ensure AI tools are accessible and impactful

Setting the Stage

- Obtain consent from caregivers
- Set clear expectations about when and how AI tools can be used
- Emphasize Al's role as an assistant, not a way to avoid work
- Introduce tools strategically, scaffolding and monitoring use
- Discuss academic integrity and responsible use

Match Tools to Student Need

Reading Support

- Text-to-speech tools like
 Speechify or Natural
 Reader
- Adjust reading level of text
- Generate summaries

Writing Support

- Writing assistance tools like Grammarly or Quill
- Speech-to-text (built into many tools)
- Scaffold the writing process

Math Support

- Adaptive instructional tools like Khanmigo or Prodigy Math
- Equatio
- Custom word problems
- Break down problems
